What happens to the appearance of objects when placed in water?

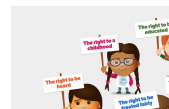
RE

Why do Hindus try to be good?



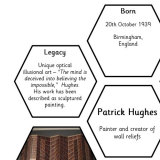
PHSE
