St Mary's Eco-Group wins £100 for our school

In the Autumn term, the ecogroup took part in a competition run by the Terracycle charity, who asked participants of the programme to share their recycling stories. We have been selected amongst the winning entries and have won £100 for school! The money will go towards a compost bin for the school garden.

Since we started the programme, we have recycled over 55kg of bread-bags, which is the equivalent of over 10,000 plastic bags! Every kilo of waste sent earns £1 for school.

We can also recycle non-disposable plastic bottles and Tupperware boxes.



ATTENDANCE ATTENDANCE MATTERS

95.1%

Our whole school attendance for this week is 95.1% which is above the national picture of 93.3%. However, our aim is to 'RISE' above this target and get our children attending school as much as possible to access even more great learning opportunities. Our own DSAT target is 96%. We are so close, let's aim to get there!



Well done FS1. At 98.5% you are leading the school for attendance. But looking at the data, all our classes are ahead of the national average!

Any classes achieving 96% or above attendance get an extra 10 minutes play. So that's great news for FS1, FS2 and Year 5.
