DfE-funded Holiday Activities with Food (HAF) Programme is back!

FREE Olympic Try Diving Taster Sessions at Ponds Forge

24th June - 18th July



Sheffield Diving Club is proud to announce that two Sheffield Divers have qualified to represent Great Britain at the Games -Yasmin Harper and Jordan Houlden! Yasmin competes on the first day of the Olympic diving events on Saturday 27th July in thew Women's 3 Metre Synchronised Final.

Sheffield Diving is the only 10 Metre Platform Diving Club in South Yorkshire, so in the run up to the Olympics, we would like to offer pupils across the City the chance to experience the unique Olympic Sport of Diving by offering children one 40 minute FREE Diving Taster Lesson in June or July.

The free sessions take place at Ponds Forge International Sports Centre and are available at various days times until 18th July.

TO TAKE PART IN THE DIVING SESSION ALL CHILDREN MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM 25 METRES AND SWIM COMPETENTLY IN DEEP WATER WITHOUT GOGGLES. We expect children to have completed the Swim England Stage 3 award or equivalent in their swimming ability.

Attending pupils will receive a Swim England Diving Pin Badge and a Participation Certificate.
