Summer Term

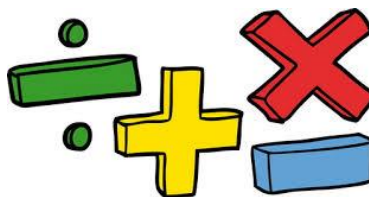


Literacy

In Literacy, we will be reading the book '**Journey**' by **Aaron Becker** and after that, the picture book '**Zereffa Giraffa**' by **Diane Hoffmeyer**. Both books link with our topic work. The children will be learning how to write **adventure story fiction** based on events in the books and develop language skills and gain knowledge about **leaflet writing** as they learn about countries of the world and the animals that live there. They will also be developing their creative writing skills and using their imagination in their learning. This term, there will be many opportunities for imaginative reading and writing in Y3.

Math

A strong focus will be improving fluency this term and we will continue to work on learning **times tables**. We will be practising tables every day and we encourage you to support your child to use **TT Rock Stars** and **Reflex Learning** at home regularly. This term, we will also learn about **fractions, mass, capacity, money, time, shape, statistics, position and direction**.



Science



The two topics for this term are **Light** and **Plants**. We will be looking at how what light is and how **shadows** are formed. As well as learning about the parts of a plant and how **leaves** make food for **plants** to grow.

RE

This term, the two RE units are **Judaism** and a **Christian** topic on **what type of world did Jesus want**. During the **Jewish** topic, children will explore what it means to be a Jew in Britain today.

The **Christian** unit will give children the opportunity to explore how and why people try to make the world a better place.

PHSE

In PHSE, the children will be discussing what is their personal information and how to keep it safe. The children will have the opportunity to **share thoughts** and ideas in class.



Creative Curriculum

History learning will focus on how life changed after the **Roman** invasion. In Geography, the children learning about **Ordinate Survey** maps and maps of scale. Then, in computing, the children understand how to use and create **branching databases** and as well as creating media through **desktop publishing** on the school Chromebooks. For Art, children will be developing their **printmaking skills** as well as learning about creative processes. And in music, Y3 will be continuing to learn how to play **glockenspiels** while learning **key music skills** and **theory**.



Trips

This term, Y3 will be visiting the **Weston Park Museum** in Sheffield to expand on our wider curriculum topics on **29th April 2025**. Children will be learning about the Romans and how their invasion impacted and changed Great Britain.

PE

This term, children will be taking part in **hockey, athletics, tennis** and **rounders**. P.E. will take place on **Tuesdays** and **Wednesdays**.
