We also had members of our own eco-club (also Green Church Award winners) tell us about what we are doing in school to be good stewards of creation.






Year 4 have been learning about the digestive system and we created our own. The children particularly enjoyed recreating the intestine with the tights and squeezing out the nutrients.




In Y2'S RE lesson's we have been learning about The Five Pillars of Islam.


