Our harvest donations this year will be going to the S6 Foodbank. If anyone would like to bring any donations, please can you bring these into your child's class by Monday 30th September.





Items urgently needed:


Contouring and Superimposin


GORILLA




Year 4 have been reading Gorilla by Anthony Browne as part of their literacy learning.

In groups, the children worked together to research gorillas.


They were able to use their interesting facts to create some fantastic writing!
















Experimenting with materials.
